

## **Golf Course Superintendent Report**



We are off to a great start this summer. The greens have been Verti-cut and Top-dressed four times this season. That is currently giving us an average greens speed of 10.5.

The new addition to the rip-rap along the creek banks these past few years has greatly reduced erosion. Especially with all the

heavy rain we have had in June this year, it is still reducing.

We added a butterfly garden off the East lounge patio. Throughout the course and around the clubhouse we have been planting new plants, trimmed bushes and mulched the flower beds.

This past season all 58 infected ash trees have been removed. Stumps were ground out, with holes filled and seeded into the grass.

The rough areas in the ravine behind 10 tee have been burned, cleared and sprayed. Our goal is to make it a natural prairie grassland. This will be more desirable for the wildlife, ecologically friendly and be more aesthetically pleasing.

I would like to thank all of the volunteers that helped in all of these projects. I'm hoping July's weather will be a great month for golf.
