President's Letter

As the calendar rolls over to July, and we begin the second half of 2019, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide our members with a summary of Geneva's financial situation.

In 2019, Geneva's finances have been adversely affected by two factors. First, even though overall membership is about the same as last year, we've lost 14 golf members in the three highest membership classifications, which translates to an expected dues shortfall of about \$50,000. The loss of these golf members also accounts for a corresponding reduction in cart and related golf fees. Second, the adverse weather conditions have reduced overall club usage, resulting in a decline in food and beverage revenue.

What are we doing to respond to these challenges?

- * Management continues to control labor costs based on usage. This tight control of our labor expense has resulted in a savings of \$20,000 so far this year.*
- * Our management team has not had a bonus or even a cost of living raise for the last two years.
- * Management has taken (and continues to take) proactive steps to secure golf and dining events that were not reflected in the 2019 budget. These outside events should generate about \$45,000 of additional revenue.
- * Management created two membership drive opportunities to encourage new membership. To date, this has resulted in 18 new golf memberships. We will be looking at additional programs in the future.
- * The kitchen has created some unique family dining options with lower price points. Made to order pizza and Geneva-To-Go weekly features are a few examples.
- * Live music and more club functions have been introduced.

Even with all our challenges, your club is in strong financial health. Your management team is dedicated to meeting the expectations of our members while controlling the Club's variable expenses. Your Board of Directors recognizes the challenges we have faced over the last few years and continues to take steps to adapt. Approximately 80% of Geneva's costs are fixed costs, so we have to focus on the remaining 20%, while keeping in mind that our members expect and deserve remarkable service every time they use the facility.

You can help by supporting and enjoying your club. If we all use Geneva even a little bit more, and if we promote Geneva to new members, the less the challenges outlined above will impact the members. Please come out more often to enjoy your club and bring your family and friends with you who may want to take advantage of Geneva's great golf and dining services we offer.

Thanks for taking time to read this update. Please let us know if you have any ideas or suggestions we can consider to improve your club experience.
