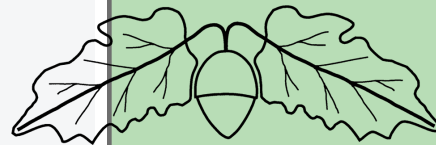

4. Please hit in front of the white rope while using the driving range.
5. ***Please check with the golf shop before teeing off. (1or 10)***
6. Please do not use the course as a practice area.
7. Please rake bunkers when leaving them.
8. Please fix your ball marks on the greens.
9. Please fix ball markers when you finish a practice session on the short game area.

Drivers of golf carts must be 16 and have a driver's license. This is extremely important.

The driving range will close two hours before sunset to allow for picking.

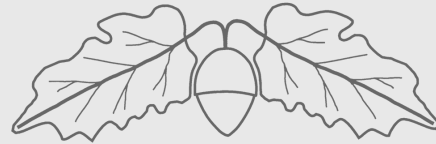
