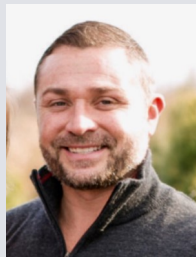

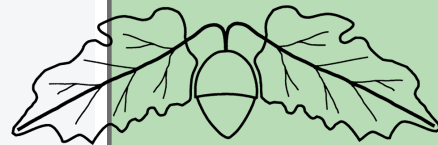
As fall is now upon us, come out and enjoy the beautiful scenery from our dining room, main lounge or West lounge and watch the leaves change and have libations.

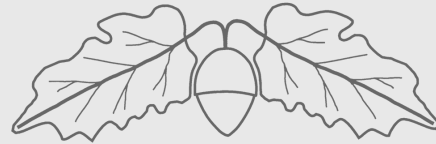
