Because we have made an effort to make conditions firm and fast this summer, we have lost a few areas on the tees and fairways. These areas will grow back in the fall. A few greens also have stressed out around the edges during hot and dry conditions. Luckily, they are starting to fill in and return to normal. We have had 2 major leaks on the main 6" line from the pumphouse in July & August. We have had a total of 28 leaks so far throughout the course this season. Our clubhouse irrigation has been repaired. It has now been up and running for a few weeks. I am hoping for some good temperatures and beautiful weather in our near future!


